RACE RELATIONS AND POLICING IN BROWARD COUNTY, FL

Given the police-racial tensions in many communities nationwide, the situation in Broward County seems quite positive.

In a poll conducted for Citizens for Effective Law Enforcement, respondents were asked:

Have you ever had an unpleasant experience with a police officer?	
Yes	15
No	85

When studied among racial demographics our survey found that 86% of white respondents and 83% of black respondents said they have never had an unpleasant experience with a police officer. This suggests police-racial relations in Broward County are strong, especially when contrasted with simmering problems in similar communities across the United States.

The poll was conducted from July 14-19, 2016 among 350 likely Democratic primary voters in Broward County who self-described themselves as likely to vote in the upcoming Democratic primary with live operators and conducted in English, Spanish or Creole according to the respondent's preference. The poll has a margin of error of +/- 5.24 percent.
